

The following items are currently being recycled by Recyclers of South Australia's members at Recycling Centres throughout the State.

Returning your items correctly saves time and energy and ensures that all items are recycled into other useful products.

ALUMINIUM BEVERAGE CANS

Please do not crush cans

All aluminium cans are accepted and refunds on deposits are paid.



DEPOSIT GLASS BOTTLES

Full refund of deposits are made at Recycling Depots.

These bottles are clearly identified with a label nominating that this beer, wine cooler or soft drink container is to be returned to Recycling Depots for refund.



PLASTIC SOFT DRINK, FRUIT JUICE AND FRUIT JUICE DRINK CONTAINERS

Remove plastic caps before returning for refund.

Fruit Juice all containers under one litre.

Fruit Juice drinks-all containers.



OTHER COMMODITIES FOR WHICH CASH IS PAID

FLAVOURED MILK, FRUIT JUICE AND FRUIT JUICE DRINK CARTONS

Containers should be drained and dry.

All sizes up to but not including one litre.

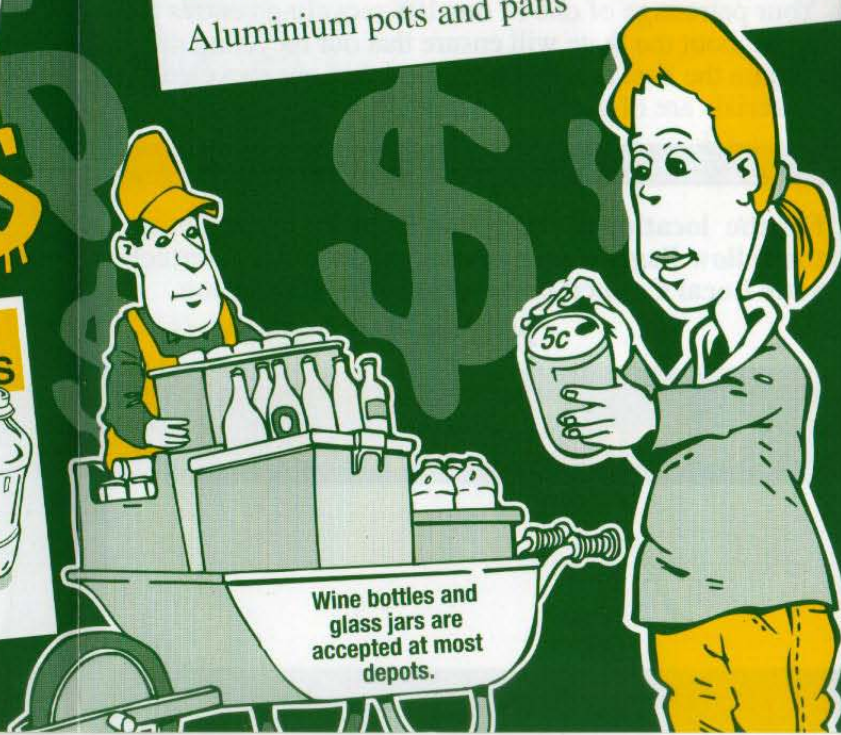
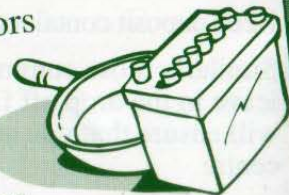


NON FERROUS METALS

Car Batteries and Radiators

Copper
Lead
Brass

Aluminium pots and pans



Wine bottles and glass jars are accepted at most depots.

DROP OFF FACILITIES

Some Recycling Centres provide facilities to drop off plastic milk containers, food tins, paperboard, newspaper and cardboard. Check with your Recycling Depot before returning these, to see if they are accepted.



TIME SAVING HINTS

Sort and keep separate all like materials.

For example:

Keep beverage cans separate from Glass and Plastic containers.

Keep deposit containers separate from other recyclables.

Similarly those commodities which you may wish to leave in the drop off facility at your depot, if sorted, will ensure that you are not delayed at the recycling centre.

Your patronage of one of our 108 recycling centres throughout the State will ensure that our recycling rates remain the best in the country and that our recycled materials are of the highest quality in the country.

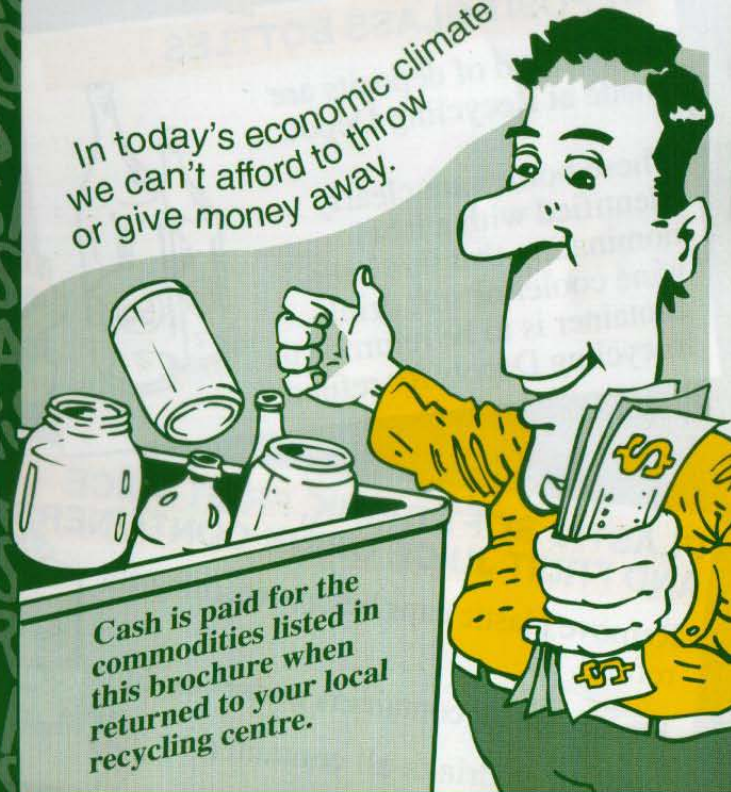
